

We create a research environment where creativity, innovation and achievements are made possible by people, infrastructure and shared values.

We aim to deliver high quality research to challenge, break barriers, discover new areas, impact society and the economy. Our focus is to support and promote research excellence through priority research areas and investment in human capital, creating an environment that will allow to conduct interdisciplinary research in collaboration with the greatest national and international teams.

We aim to deepen research collaboration at home and abroad and therefore build solid relationships with various partners in science and education, health, sports, tourism and leisure sectors.

We plan to invest strategically in creating and strengthening the areas of excellence. Strengthening the scientific and technological base will ensure that our researchers are able to conduct high quality research and showcase innovation.

We will increase the level of external investment in our research and our participation in advanced scientific projects carried out within international public-private partnerships, ensuring a balanced structure of funding streams and stable Academy's finances.

We will provide a comfortable environment for research by creating a high organisational culture and a modern working environment.

We will increase the impact of our research on public policy, with particular emphasis on health, education, tourism, urban planning, the labour market and social policy, especially in terms of the potential of sport to build social capital and impact the economy.


We will concentrate our resources on creating and strengthening the areas of excellence. The investments will make our Academy an attractive and sustainable place, able to meet the needs of the future.

The achievement of the specific objectives in the area of research will be measured on the basis of the following indicators:

- increased visibility of our research evidenced with a larger number of publications in major journals with a higher journal's impact factor
- ability to raise research funds resulting from grants and prestigious awards won by our scientists, and the research commercialization
- increased attractiveness of our Academy for a larger number of most talented students, retaining them and utilising their potential
- intensified research targeted towards key areas and social challenges considering international, national and regional aspects

The objectives in the area of education

The achievement of the specific objectives in the area of education will be measured on the basis of the following indicators:

- our students' evaluation expressed as a number of academic and sport awards and scholarships
- students' evaluation of academic teachers and the curriculum
- employability, the value we provide our students with in the labour market
- increased attractiveness of our Academy for a larger candidate application; our market share
- evaluation of our academic courses, both nationally and internationally

The objectives in the area of sport

The achievement of the specific objectives in the area of sport will be measured on the basis of the following indicators:

- the number of students, academic teachers and coaching staff practising competitive sports
- the number of students with sporting achievements at national and international levels
- the number of coaching staff with considerable sporting achievements
- the number of athletic scholarships available for students

The objectives in the area of research

- 1. Category A achieved in the process of evaluation of scientific activities.
- 2. Establishing cooperation with two major international scientific and higher education institutions.
- 3. Enlisting scientists with outstanding academic achievements.
- 4. Finding a business partner in the area of research addressed to the entity's specifics.
- 5. Promotion of the support for commercialization of the research results.
- 6. Support for young scientists at the beginning of their career path by experienced researchers and with a dedicated scholarship scheme.
- 7. Introducing the list of "preferable" journals for better visibility and excellence.

The objectives in the area of education

- 1. Introducing career paths for academic teachers.
- 2. Popularization of scientific research, e.g. by student science clubs.
- 3. Extending the offer for foreign students, e.g. launching courses in English.
- 4. Signing new agreements for student exchange programmes with international centres.
- 5. Introducing dual studies.
- 6. Maintaining our high position in the course and university rankings.
- 7. Increasing the number of foreign students.

The objectives in the area of sports

- 1. Strengthening our cooperation with institutions operating in the area of sport and public health.
- 2. Cooperation with the Olympic-bound athletes in order to provide support and expertise.
- 3. Organizing quarterly meetings with "champions" (coaches, athletes, business people) for students.
- 4. Promotion for sport and through sport the Academy of Physical Education / Academic Sport Association brand building.

The objectives in the area of influence

- 1. Creating an expert group for supporting public administration in decision-making concerning sport training and the general aspects of health, as well as exchanging information on the Academy and the region's current affairs.
- 2. Appointing an ambassador for the public and private sectors in the areas of the Academy's interests.
- 3. Organizing meetings with the representatives of public administration to establish their recruitment needs, employees' competence, and to define the social policy for which the Academy will educate their staff.
- 4. Enhancing the implementation of the research results by entities associated with the Academy.
- 5. Promotion of communication and dissemination of research results and expertise through a dedicated website.
- 6. Raising awareness of social responsibility in social media.

The objectives in the area of capital

- 1. Establishing a special purpose vehicle for the commercialization of the research results and know-how transfer, and for providing socially useful services.
- 2. Developing partnerships with academic and business entities at the national level.
- 3. Efforts towards ensuring balanced financial condition.
